Durham Museum

Beautiful architecture blends with memories of a time gone by at The Durham Museum. Making its home in one of Omaha's most unique treasures - Union Station, The Durham Museum offers a fascinating look at the history of this region and offers a broad range of traveling exhibits covering subjects ranging from history and culture to science, industry and more. Journey through times past with transportation from CHI to the Durham Museum where you will have time to browse the exhibits in this beautiful venue.

Spouse/Guest Lunch at Lauritzen Gardens with tour of the Botanical Gardens

Escape to an urban oasis of beauty and tranquility to enjoy lunch with your ASABE friends in the glory of Lauritzen Gardens. Discover this hidden sanctuary in the heart of the city, a botanical garden conveniently located along the beautiful riverfront hills. Relax after lunch while cultivating your mind as you wander through the living plant museum featuring unique seasonal plant displays that are maintained to the highest standards consistent with environmental stewardship. Discover 100 acres of inspiring horticultural displays, including the Rose Garden, Victorian Garden, Children's Garden, Model Railroad Garden, and the Marjorie K. Daugherty Conservatory featuring indoor tropical and temperate garden spaces. Also included is a tram tour to view the far-reaching acreage, and time to browse the Visitor's Center with gift shop.

Cuisines: Omaha Classics – A Private Cooking Class

Omaha is home to some classic “American” foods, and the Metropolitan Community College Culinary Arts School has developed an Open Kitchen Workshop especially for you to learn more about these local classics. During the 3-hour session with instructors from the Culinary School, discover what makes Rueben sandwiches, cheese Frenchees, and Butterbrickle ice cream the Omaha favorites they’ve become. Take part in a culinary school environment to learn the techniques needed for you to make these specialties at home. Each participant will get to enjoy eating all three Omaha classics at the end of the lesson.

A Visit to General Crook Museum with Afternoon Tea

The General Crook House is the award-winning, authentically restored home of General George Crook at Fort Omaha. The Italianate house built in 1879 and on the National Register of Historic Places, shows how a Commanding Officer lived on the Frontier in the 1880s. An elegant Afternoon Tea with scones, fruit and tea will be served in the Crook House dining room with a proper silver tea service and fresh flowers. Included is a guided tour of the beautifully appointed rooms and the heirloom garden with more than 110 varieties of flowers and plants.



Cost: \$45 per person (note: There is a maximum number of 20 allowed for this tour)
